De deltagende stater vil træffe passende foranstaltninger til at sikre virkeliggørelsen af denne ret, idet de anerkender, at internationalt samarbejde på frivilligt grundlag er af væsentlig betydning i denne henseende.</p> <p>12.1 De i denne konvention deltagende stater anerkender ethvert menneskes ret til at nyde den højst opnåelige fysiske og psykiske sundhed.</p> <p>12.2 De foranstaltninger, deltagerne i denne konvention skal træffe for at opnå den fulde virkeliggørelse af denne ret, skal omfatte sådanne som er nødvendige for at 12.2.b forbedre alle sider af de hygiejniske forhold i det menneskelige miljø og på arbejdsplassen;</p> <p><b>Show all articles</b> 24.2 Deltagerstaterne skal arbejde for fuld gennemførelse af denne ret og især tage passende forholdsregler for: 24.2.c at bekæmpe sygdom og underernæring, herunder inden for rammerne af den primære sundhedspleje, blandt andet ved anvendelse af let tilgængelig teknologi og gennem ydelse af tilstrækkelig og nærende mad og rent drukkevand under hensyntagen til de farer og risici, der er knyttet til forurening af miljøet;</p> <p><b>Show all articles</b> 14.2 De deltagende stater skal træffe alle passende foranstaltninger til at afskaffe diskrimination imod kvinder i landområder med henblik på at sikre, at de, på grundlag af ligestilling mellem mænd og kvinder, deltager i og opnår udbytte af udviklingen i landområder, og især til at sikre disse kvinder retten til: 14.2.h at have passende levevilkår, herunder især med hensyn til bolig, sanitære forhold, elektricitets- og vandforsyning, transport og kommunikation.</p> <p><b>Show all articles</b> 28.2 Deltagerstaterne anerkender, at personer med handicap har ret til social tryghed og til at nyde denne ret uden diskrimination på grund af handicap, og skal tage passende skridt til at sikre og fremme virkeliggørelsen af denne ret, herunder ved foranstaltninger til: 28.2.a at sikre personer med handicap lige adgang til forsyning med rent vand og at sikre adgang til passende tilbud, udstyr og anden bistand til handicap-relaterede behov til en overkommelig pris,</p> <p><b>Show all articles</b> 1 The objective of the present Agreement is to guarantee the full and effective implementation in Latin America and the Caribbean of the rights of access to environmental information, public participation in the environmental decision-making process and access to justice in environmental matters, and the creation and strengthening of capacities and cooperation, contributing to the protection of the right of every person of present and future generations to live in a healthy environment and to sustainable development.</p> <p>4.1 Each Party shall guarantee the right of every person to live in a healthy environment and any other universally-recognized human right related to the present Agreement.</p>

		<p>4.2 Each Party shall ensure that the rights recognized in the present Agreement are freely exercised.</p>
		<p>4.3 Each Party shall adopt the necessary measures, of a legislative, regulatory, administrative or any other nature, in the framework of its domestic provisions, to guarantee the implementation of the provisions of the present Agreement.</p>
		<p>6.1 Each Party shall guarantee, to the extent possible within available resources, that the competent authorities generate, collect, publicize and disseminate environmental information relevant to their functions in a systematic, proactive, timely, regular, accessible and comprehensible manner, and periodically update this information and encourage the disaggregation and decentralization of environmental information at the subnational and local levels. Each Party shall strengthen coordination between the different authorities of the State.</p>
		<p>6.3 Each Party shall have in place one or more up-to-date environmental information systems, which may include, inter alia:</p>
		<p>6.3.e information on the use and conservation of natural resources and ecosystem services;</p>
		<p>6.9 Each Party shall promote access to environmental information contained in concessions, contracts, agreements or authorizations granted, which involve the use of public goods, services or resources, in accordance with domestic legislation.</p>
		<p>6.10 Each Party shall ensure that consumers and users have official, relevant and clear information on the environmental qualities of goods and services and their effects on health, favouring sustainable production and consumption patterns.</p>
		<p>6.12 Each Party shall take the necessary measures, through legal or administrative frameworks, among others, to promote access to environmental information in the possession of private entities, in particular information on their operations and the possible risks and effects on human health and the environment.</p>
		<p>11.1 The Parties shall cooperate to strengthen their national capacities with the aim of implementing the present Agreement in an effective manner.</p>
		<p>11.2 The Parties shall give particular consideration to least developed countries, landlocked developing countries and small island developing States from Latin America and the Caribbean.</p>
		<p>11.3 For the purposes of implementing paragraph 2 of the present article, the Parties shall promote activities and mechanisms, such as:</p>
		<p>11.3.a discussions, workshops, expert exchanges, technical assistance, education and observatories;</p>
		<p>11.3.b developing, sharing and implementing educational, training and awareness-raising materials and programmes;</p>
		<p>11.3.c sharing experiences of voluntary codes of conduct, guidelines, good practices and standards;</p>
		<p>11.3.d committees, councils and forums of multisectoral development stakeholders to address cooperation priorities and activities.</p>
		<p>11.4 The Parties shall encourage partnerships with States from other regions, intergovernmental, non-governmental, academic and private organizations, as well as civil society organizations and other relevant stakeholders to implement the present Agreement.</p>
		<p>11.5 The Parties recognize that regional cooperation and information-sharing shall be promoted in relation to all aspects of illicit activities against the environment.</p>
		<p>13 Each Party, to the extent of its ability and in accordance with its national priorities, commits to provide the resources for national activities that are needed to fulfil the obligations derived from the present Agreement.</p>
