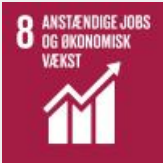

Indicators 8.2.1 Antal af kommercielle bankfilialer og pengeautomater pr. 100.000 voksne	UDHR Verdenserklæringen om menneskerettighederne	Show all articles 27.1 Enhver har ret til frit at deltage i samfundets kulturelle liv, til kunstrnydelse og til at blive delagtiggjort i videnskabens fremskridt og dens goder. 27.2 Enhver har ret til beskyttelse af de moralske og materielle interesser, der hidrører fra en hvilken som helst videnskabelig, litterær eller kunstnerisk frembringelse, som vedkommende har skabt.
		ICESCR Den internationale konvention om økonomiske, sociale og kulturelle rettigheder	Show all articles 15.1 De i denne konvention deltagende stater anerkender enhvers ret til at: 15.1.b nyde fordel af videnskabens fremskridt og dens anvendelse; 15.2 De foranstaltninger, enhver af de i denne konvention deltagende stater træffer med henblik på at sikre denne ret, skal omfatte sådanne som er nødvendige for at bevare, udvikle og udbrede videnskab og kultur. 15.3 De i denne konvention deltagende stater forpligter sig til at respektere den frihed, der er uundværlig for videnskabelig forskning og skabende virksomhed. 15.4 De i denne konvention deltagende stater anerkender de goder, der kan opnås ved at fremme og udvikle internationale forbindelser og samarbejde på de videnskabelige og kulturelle områder.
		ADRDM American Declaration on the Rights and Duties of Man	Show all articles XIII Every person has the right to take part in the cultural life of the community, to enjoy the arts, and to participate in the benefits that result from intellectual progress, especially scientific discoveries. He likewise has the right to the protection of his moral and material interests as regards his inventions or any literary, scientific or artistic works of which he is the author.
		ACHR American Convention on Human Rights	Show all articles 26 The States Parties undertake to adopt measures, both internally and through international cooperation, especially those of an economic and technical nature, with a view to achieving progressively, by legislation or other appropriate means, the full realization of the rights implicit in the economic, social, educational, scientific, and cultural standards set forth in the Charter of the Organization of American States as amended by the Protocol of Buenos Aires.
		Protocol of San Salvador Additional Protocol to the American Convention on Human Rights in the Area of Economic, Social and Cultural rights (Protocol of San Salvador)	Show all articles 14.1 The States Parties to this Protocol recognize the right of everyone: 14.1.b To enjoy the benefits of scientific and technological progress; 14.2 The steps to be taken by the States Parties to this Protocol to ensure the full exercise of this right shall include those necessary for the conservation, development and dissemination of science, culture and art. 14.3 The States Parties to this Protocol undertake to respect the freedom indispensable for scientific research and creative activity.

		ACHPR African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights	Show all articles 22.1 All peoples shall have the right to their economic, social and cultural development with due regard to their freedom and identity and in the equal enjoyment of the common heritage of mankind.
		Maputo Protocol Protocol to the African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights on the Rights of Women in Africa	Show all articles 18.2 States Parties shall take all appropriate measures to:
			18.2.b promote research and investment in new and renewable energy sources and appropriate technologies, including information technologies and facilitate women's access to, and participation in their control;
			18.2.c protect and enable the development of women's indigenous knowledge systems;

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
