		<b>ADRDM</b> American Declaration on the Rights and Duties of Man	<a href="#">Show all articles</a> <b>XIII</b> Every person has the right to take part in the cultural life of the community, to enjoy the arts, and to participate in the benefits that result from intellectual progress, especially scientific discoveries. He likewise has the right to the protection of his moral and material interests as regards his inventions or any literary, scientific or artistic works of which he is the author.
