De deltagende stater vil træffe passende foranstaltninger til at sikre virkeliggørelsen af denne ret, idet de anerkender, at internationalt samarbejde på frivilligt grundlag er af væsentlig betydning i denne henseende.</p> <p>Show all articles 16.2.c The provision of technical assistance to Parties that are developing countries and Parties with economies in transition in matters relating to this Protocol.</p> <p>Show all articles 4.10 The Parties may promote knowledge of the provisions of the present Agreement in other international forums related to environmental matters, in accordance with the rules of each forum.</p> <p>7.12 Each Party shall promote, where appropriate and in accordance with domestic legislation, public participation in international forums and negotiations on environmental matters or with an environmental impact, in accordance with the procedural rules on participation of each forum. The participation of the public at the national level on matters of international environmental forums shall also be promoted, where appropriate.</p> <p>10.2 Each Party, in line with its capacities, may take, inter alia, the following measures:</p> <p>10.2.a train authorities and civil servants on environmental access rights;</p> <p>10.2.b develop and strengthen environmental law and access rights awareness-raising and capacity-building programmes for, inter alia, the public, judicial and administrative officials, national human rights institutions and jurists;</p> <p>10.2.c provide the competent institutions and entities with adequate equipment and resources;</p> <p>10.2.d promote education and training on, and raise public awareness of, environmental matters, through, inter alia, basic educational modules on access rights for students at all levels of education;</p>

		<p>10.2.e develop specific measures for persons or groups in vulnerable situations, such as providing interpreters or translators in languages other than official languages when necessary;</p> <p>10.2.f acknowledge the importance of associations, organizations or groups that train the public on or raise public awareness of access rights;</p> <p>10.2.g strengthen capabilities to collect, retain and evaluate environmental information.</p>
		<p>11.1 The Parties shall cooperate to strengthen their national capacities with the aim of implementing the present Agreement in an effective manner.</p>
		<p>11.2 The Parties shall give particular consideration to least developed countries, landlocked developing countries and small island developing States from Latin America and the Caribbean.</p>
		<p>11.3 For the purposes of implementing paragraph 2 of the present article, the Parties shall promote activities and mechanisms, such as:</p>
		<p>11.3.a discussions, workshops, expert exchanges, technical assistance, education and observatories;</p>
		<p>11.3.b developing, sharing and implementing educational, training and awareness-raising materials and programmes;</p>
		<p>11.3.c sharing experiences of voluntary codes of conduct, guidelines, good practices and standards;</p>
		<p>11.3.d committees, councils and forums of multisectoral development stakeholders to address cooperation priorities and activities.</p>
		<p>11.4 The Parties shall encourage partnerships with States from other regions, intergovernmental, non-governmental, academic and private organizations, as well as civil society organizations and other relevant stakeholders to implement the present Agreement.</p>
		<p>11.5 The Parties recognize that regional cooperation and information-sharing shall be promoted in relation to all aspects of illicit activities against the environment.</p>

Staterne skal desuden samarbejde om udvikling af parternes teknologiske kapacitet navnlig hos de parter, som har behov for og anmoder om teknisk bistand på dette område, 14.1 Parterne er enige om, at der i overensstemmelse med forskel lige regioners og sub-regioners særlige behov bør oprettes regionale eller sub-regionale centre for uddannelse og teknologioverførsel om håndtering af farligt affald eller andet affald og om begrænsning af frembringelsen af affald. Parterne træffer bestemmelse om etablering af egnede finansieringsmekanismer baseret på frivillighed.
